SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status – Yemen

Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing armed conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

Details:

The Secretary of Homeland Security announced the termination of Yemen's Temporary Protected Status (TPS).

TPS beneficiaries who provide an approved EAD card with categories A12 or C19 and/or an approved I-821 with an expiration date of March 3, 2023, September 3, 2024, and March 3, 2026, are entitled to a credential valid until May 4, 2026.

For over-the-counter transactions that do not verify in VLS, the issuance must be abandoned, and a temporary permit may be issued, not to extend past May 4, 2026. Individuals who do not meet the requirements outlined in the ADT are not eligible for issuance or for a temporary permit.
